Yaqeen's Ramadan Series Connects Millions of Muslims

From Dallas to Dhaka, Yaqeen's latest Ramadan production explores life, loss, and the unseen world that follows.

ach Ramadan night, as
cities quieted for prayer
and reflection, screens lit
up across the globe. This
year, more than 20.5 million
viewers in over 180 countries tuned
in to Yaqeen's Ramadan series, The
Other Side: Barzakh and Beyond—
a digital gathering that turned private
homes into shared spaces of faith.

A THEOLOGY FOR A GRIEVING WORLD

Yaqeen's annual Ramadan series has become a mainstay for Muslims worldwide. Past seasons have wrestled with the problem of evil and answered the question of how believers can reconcile divine mercy with human suffering.

This year, The Other Side confronted the next step in that journey: death, the afterlife, and the unseen transition in between.

Each episode invited viewers to see death as the next step, and came paired with **daily discussion guides**

From Cairo's cafés to living rooms in London and Toronto, viewers watched together, posted reflections, and shared takeaways online across Yaqeen's platforms.



rtificial intelligence is reshaping how the world learns, searches, and thinks. For Muslims seeking credible Islamic knowledge in this new landscape, Yaqeen's Al, Ask Aqsa, offers a way to use new technology while feeling certain they can trust the results.

Built in-house and trained exclusively on Yaqeen's verified research library, Aqsa allows users to **ask questions in natural language** ("Why am I so sad even if I'm Muslim?", "How do I start learning more about Islam?") and receive empathetic, evidence-based responses as well as resources to answer their questions.

WHY IT MATTERS

Standard AI models are not neutral. As byproducts of human writing and human training, they absorb biased beliefs about the world, and then share that information as fact with users.

Aqsa represents Yaqeen's belief that as AI becomes integrated into daily life, it must be trained with guidance that's rooted in Islamic ethics, not left to systems built without any moral framework. •

Prioritizing *Du'a*, No Matter How Busy

hen 21-year-old Sana settled into her new dorm at Hamline University, she quickly realized something would be very different. "In my family, my Baba was always the one reminding me to make *du'a*. Whenever I was stressed about something, or wanted to know how to pray for a goal I wanted to achieve, he helped me find the best ways to ask." Without him, things are a little harder.

Sana still calls her father to learn from him about du'a, but in the hectic pace of college life, she needed an extra way to get that reminder every day. Yaqeen's Ameen app helps users make du'a a top priority, no matter how busy they are. Ameen sets itself apart with daily reminders, curated du'as, custom "praylists," and an Al-powered du'a finder that finds supplications from the Qur'an and Sunnah for users' specific needs, whether spiritual, emotional, or practical.

"The other day, I was so worried about a test that I just typed in 'Stressed about exam tomorrow' into the app," Sana's friend Hafsa said, "and it gave me a *du'a* to make but also reminded me that I should do my best and then trust in Allah. That helped me relax a little bit so I could keep studying."


The app customizes itself for individual user needs, but also includes features reminding users to **make** *du'a* for others, encouraging empathy and collective remembrance. Early usage data shows a growing network of users making thousands of prayers each week for family, friends, and even strangers.

For now, Sana says, "An app can never replace Baba's reminders, but it helps me just like he would during the times that we're apart." •

he bell rings at Ms. Amina's Islamic middle school. Backpacks zip shut, sneakers shuffle, and a new kind of lesson begins.

Today's topic is ethics. The seventh graders settle in as their teacher cues up a Yaqeen lesson titled "Love at First Sight." Some students giggle, wondering if this is really something they're going to study.

It is. This is one of Yaqeen's newest curriculum units, part of a growing library of classroom-ready lessons designed to equip Muslim youth to think critically and successfully navigate complex moral questions.

EDUCATION FOR AN UNCERTAIN ERA

For young students, online influences and social pressures often outweigh parental guidance. Yaqeen's curricula helps students think critically and base their knowledge in Islamic principles.

Love at First Sight tackles one of the most pressing and confusing topics in youth culture: gender and sexual ethics. The lessons guide students to explore attraction, self-respect, and responsibility through an Islamic lens.

IN THE CLASSROOM

Lessons include presentations, guided discussions, and reflection prompts that invite honest conversation. Teachers report that students are suddenly engaged, having never studied anything like the topic of desire in a classroom before. Some students say that they haven't had the opportunity to discuss sexual ethics and infatuation with any adults in their lives, only with their friends.

"These topics can be awkward, but Yaqeen's materials make them approachable for students," said Ms. Amina. "The lesson plans give us the language to talk about love, desire, infatuation, and making good choices—and my students are actually paying attention! They're so relieved to be able to talk about this."

RIGOR MEETS REAL LIFE

Developed by Yageen's team of scholars and professional educators, Yaqeen Curriculum is now utilized in over 1,600 schools and youth groups worldwide. It's freely available online and designed for formal classrooms as well as weekend programs.

Each unit covers a topic that is both practical and crucial, from understanding why we worship God to why taking care of the environment is important. Every unit includes downloadable lesson plans, teacher guides, and discussion activities, all attuned to modern struggles Muslim students face today.

Yaqeen's pedagogical approach is simple: meet young Muslims where they are, and help them see through all the cultural noise to the moral clarity of their faith.

Video Series Reconnects Muslims to Palestine



ate in 2024, Yaqeen Institute released its Al-Aqsa video series, drawing Muslims into the spiritual history of Palestine. The timing allowed viewers to connect with Palestine, even as their hearts broke for Gaza.

"I want to take you to the year 614," said **Dr. Omar Suleiman** to open the series. "Imagine that you are one of the first Muslims waking up to a reality of persecution in Mecca." He explained that Jerusalem was the first *qiblah* of the early believers, asking viewers to understand the devotion they carried in their hearts toward a sanctuary they had never seen. "It's a powerful visual," he said, and a visual many viewers could relate to, having never visited Al-Quds in person themselves.

The series traced the prophets who lived and prayed in the Holy Land, connecting viewers to Jerusalem across generations. In one segment, he recounted the miracle of Maryam introducing Prophet Isa in the very heart of the sacred city:

"She sits in the courtyard of Al-Aqsa, holding her child...and in that place, when they say, 'How could you do this?' she points to the baby. And the baby leaves the breast of his mother and starts to speak: 'Indeed, I am the

servant of Allah. He has given me the Scripture and made me a prophet."

The lectures were anchored in Qur'anic references and historical context, offering viewers a framework for engagement with Palestine beyond images of destruction.

The series included a prayer reflecting the ongoing struggles in Gaza:

"We ask Allah to bless all of the people of Ash-Sham...to shower His mercy upon them...and to guide toward victory all of those who wish them well."

Through this series, Yaqeen reconnected Muslims worldwide to Palestine's spiritual and historical significance, offering a sense of hope amid widespread suffering. ◆



Qur'an 30for30 Brings Sacred Lessons to Life

f Yaqeen's Barzakh series offered spiritual inspiration for Ramadan viewers, Qur'an 30for30 provided spiritual grounding. For many, Qur'an 30for30 has become another integral part of their holy month. In its sixth year, the Yaqeen Institute series guided viewers through the Qur'an one *juz* at a time, offering lessons and insights from dozens of familiar faces of knowledge.

Co-hosted by Dr. Omar Suleiman and Sh. Abdullah Oduro, the series brings together scholars and teachers from across the Muslim world. This year's guests included Sh. Joe Bradford, Sh. Belal Assaad, Mufti Menk, Dr. Tesneem Alkiek, and Ustadha Sarah Sultan, among many other luminaries. Their conversations covered everything from social justice to divorce, helping viewers rediscover what the Qur'an means in the context of modern life.

For some, Quran 30for 30 is a first introduction to the Qur'an's deeper meanings. For others, it is a return to *taqwa* after years of spiritual distance. Viewers describe it as a series that brings the holy book back to the forefront of their minds.

Families and friends used them to discuss themes of mercy, resilience, and repentance at the dinner table or before Fajr prayers.

Through Qur'an 30for30, Yaqeen continues its work as a wayfinder for believers navigating a demanding world. The series has helped millions reconnect with revelation in a way that feels personal, practical, and deeply rooted in tradition. ◆


