

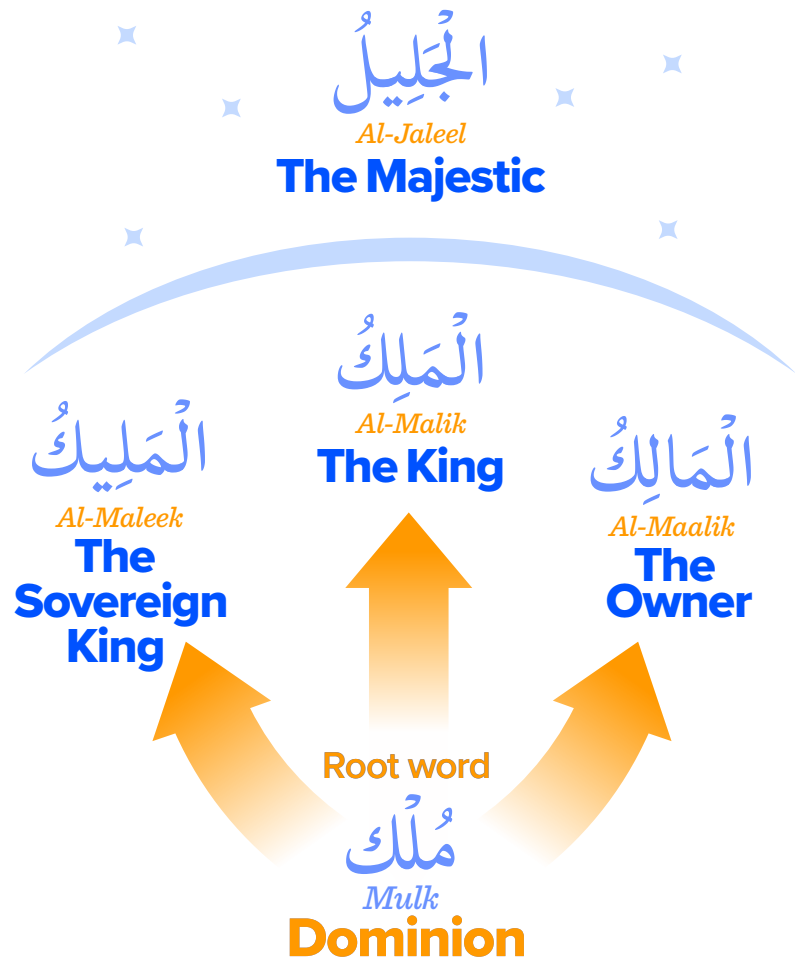

Kingship

Al-Malik (The King) needs no validation. His kingship was never gained, inherited, or voted upon. When every earthly throne collapses, His alone remains. **Al-Maalik (The Owner)** possesses everything, humbling us to the realization that we own nothing, not those we love, not our wealth, not even ourselves. In the Qur'an, Allah often pairs His kingship with His attributes of mercy and peace: Ar-Rahman, Ar-Raheem, and As-Salaam, so we never mistake Him for a harsh ruler. **Al-Maleek (The Sovereign King)** affirms that no command is resisted and no kingdom rivals His. **Al-Jaleel (The Majestic)** inspires awe that humbles without humiliation. Each night, He calls, "I am the King," inviting repentance and mercy. On the Day of Judgment, He will declare, "I am the King. Where are the tyrants now?" How we respond now determines which call we hear then.



Conversation prompt

Allah is **Al-Maleek**, the Sovereign King. If everything ultimately belongs to Allah, how should that change the way we make decisions and relate to our things, careers, money, and time? Does it make life feel more freeing or more accountable?

Reflection

"Am I living like someone who will stand before **Al-Maleek**, whose decree I cannot escape?"

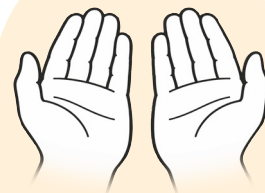
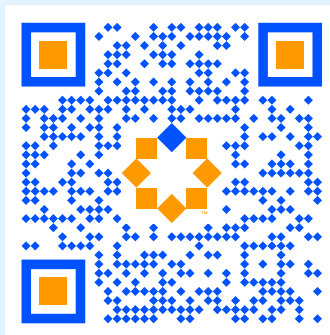
