Witness

Allah reminds us that we are never unseen or forgotten. **Al-Baseer (The All-Seeing)** sees beyond what people show. He sees every layer of pain, sadness, and quiet struggle.

Ash-Shaheed (The Supreme Witness) not only sees but bears witness to every hidden moment of patience, sincerity, and effort, even when no one else notices.

Ar-Raqeeb (The Ever-Watchful) watches over our actions and the intentions behind them, guiding us to guard our hearts and live with awareness of His care.

And **As-Sitteer (The Concealer)**, in His mercy, covers our faults, giving us space to return, heal, and grow, while teaching us to cover others' faults as we hope for ours to be covered.

Together, these Names invite us to live with *ihsan*, comfort those who are hurting, and remind us that Allah sees our struggle and cares for us with mercy.



Reflection

Write everyone's name on small pieces of paper and place them in a jar. Each person draws one piece of paper and keeps the name secret. Over the next 24 hours, do a kind action for that person without telling them (e.g., clean their space, take out the trash, fill up their gas tank, etc.).

Tomorrow, everyone tries to guess what good deeds were done and by whom. Then, reveal the acts—not to show off, but as a reminder

that Allah is **Ar-Raqeeb**: He sees every intention, thought, and effort, even when no one else could.

Reflect on those unseen efforts and deeds that only **Ar-Raqeeb** bore witness to, such as how long you had to wait in line, or what you weren't able to buy for yourself because you paid for their gas. Although people may notice what you did, they may never know the effort or sacrifice behind all of it, but Allah always knows.

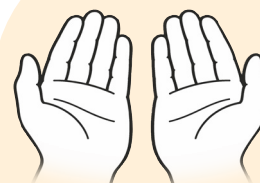
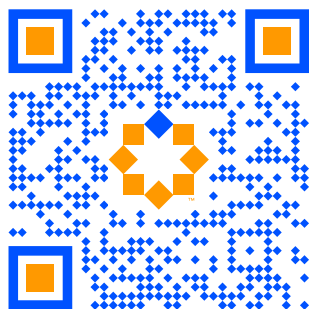
